

# Prayer Promises from the Scriptures

## Praise / Adoration

- “I will call on the Lord who is worthy to be praised; So shall I be saved from my enemies” (2 Samuel 22:4).
- “I will bless the Lord at all times: His praise shall continually be in my mouth” (Psalm 34:1).
- “O magnify the Lord with me and let us exalt his name together” (Psalm 34:3).
- “Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God; for I shall yet praise Him, the help of my countenance and my God” (Psalm 42:11).
- “I will freely sacrifice unto you: I will praise thy name, O Lord; for it is good” (Psalm 54:6).
- “Because Your loving-kindness is better than life, my lips shall praise You” (Psalm 63:3).
- “Enter into his gates with thanksgiving and into his courts with praise” (Psalm 100:4).
- “Oh, that men would praise the Lord for his goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men” (Psalm 107:8).
- “I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvelous are Your works” (Psalm 139:14)
- “Every day will I bless You; and I will praise Your name forever and ever” (Psalm 145:2).
- “I will mention the loving-kindnesses of the LORD and the praises of the LORD, according to all that the LORD has bestowed on us, and the great goodness toward the house of Israel, which He has bestowed on them according to His mercies, according to the multitude of His loving-kindnesses” (Isaiah 63:7).

- “But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;” (1 Peter 2:9).
- “You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created” (Revelation 4:11).

## Confession

- “Make me know my transgression and my sin” (Job 13:23).
- “I acknowledged my sin to You, and my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, “I will confess my transgressions to the LORD,” and You forgave the iniquity of my sin” (Psalm 32:5).
- “I acknowledge my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. Against You, You only, have I sinned, and done this evil in Your sight” (Psalm 51:3,4)
- “He who covers his sins will not prosper, but whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy” (Proverbs 28:13).
- “But we are all like an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags; we all fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away” (Isaiah 64:6)
- “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness” (1 John 1:9).
- “Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases” (Psalm 103:2, 3).
- “For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive, and abundant in mercy to all those who call upon You” (Psalm 86:5).
- “If You, LORD, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You, that You may be feared” (Psalm 130:3,4”

- “For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is His mercy toward them that fear him. As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us” (Psalm 103:11, 12).

## Supplication

- “If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land” (2 Chronicles 7:14).
- “Ask and it will be given you, seek and you will find, knock and the door will be opened unto you” (Matthew 7:7).
- “And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive” (Matthew 21:22).
- “And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son” (John 14:13).
- “For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need” (Hebrews 4:16).
- “Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know” (Jeremiah 33:3).
- “God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver you” (Psalm 50:15).
- “Cast your burden on the LORD, And He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved” (Psalm 55:22).
- “They that seek the Lord shall not lack any good thing” (Psalm 34:10).
- “Thou open Your hand and satisfy the desire of every living thing” (Psalm 145:16).

## Thanksgiving

- “Be thankful to Him, and bless His name. For the LORD *is* good; His mercy is everlasting, And His truth endures to all generations” (Psalm 100:4-5).
- “But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ” (1 Corinthians 15:57).
- “O give thanks to the Lord; for He is good; for His mercy endures forever” (1 Chronicles 16:34).
- “Rejoice in the Lord always: and again I will say, rejoice” (Philippians 4:4)
- “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus” (Philippians 4:6).
- “Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving” (Colossians 4:2)
- “In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God concerning you” (1 Thessalonians 5:18).
- “Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place” (2 Corinthians 2:14).
- “Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift” (2 Corinthians 9:15).
