The Prayer Room is a place where we come to meet with our God in prayer. Please follow these guidelines so that it remains a sacred place for everyone.

Use your MOUTH...

- For prayer, not conversations. If you find yourself talking, please exit to other areas of our building.
- To speak quietly when praying with a group.
- To speak silently when others are praying individually.

Use your HANDS....

- In a respectful way.
- Always ask before placing your hands on others.

Use this SPACE...

- For prayer and meditation. Do not bring food or drinks into the prayer room.
- To sit or kneel, but do not lie down on the chairs or sleep in the prayer room.
- With respect to others. If the room is crowded, limit your personal space to one chair. Keep all personal items with you. When you leave, take all personal items with you so that others may have a pleasant space to pray.

CHILDREN...

- Are welcome with their parents.
- Should not be left unsupervised in the prayer room.
